Adkins, McBride, Messina, Morgan and Stuart will appear on the evening's second show at 9:30 p.m. Opry members Diamond Rio and Lynn as well as special guests John Berry and Paisley will appear on the Friday Night Opry beginning at 7:30 p.m.

Oct. 15th Birthday Bash activities also include a performance of the Ryman Auditorium's Smoke On The Mountain.

A Grand Ole Opry Open House from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m Oct. 16th will provide visitors the opportunity to walk across the Opry stage, tour artists' dressing rooms, send fan mail at the Opry Post Office and visit with Opry favorites. Oct. 16th's activities also include the Bill Monroe Bluegrass Celebration at 2:30 p.m. Artists scheduled to perform are the Opry's Mike Snider and the Osborne Brothers, the Del McCoury Band, Mac Wiseman, the Larry Stephenson Band, and Dale Ann Bradley and Coon Creek.
